BAND EXCURSION TO *MAMMA MIA*

Dear Students / Parents / Guardians,

Earlier this term, I sought expressions of interest for an excursion to attend the new Australian production of *Mamma Mia*, which opens in November at the Canberra Theatre. I am happy to let everyone know that there was enough interest, even at a non-discounted price, and the excursion will go ahead!

The excursion will take place on **Wednesday December 13**. This opportunity is **optional** for the students and the first **seventy** students to **return their note and pay their deposit** will be able to go. The total cost of this excursion is \$95, which covers coach hire and a ticket to the show. **A deposit of \$50 is required by Friday November 3 (Week 4) to secure a place on the excursion.** The balance of \$45 is due by Friday December 1. Students will have the opportunity to purchase lunch in the Canberra Centre before the show, or they can bring a packed lunch with them.
