ATHLETICS CARNIVAL **Thursday 19th October 2017**

Dear Parent / Guardian,

We will be holding our annual Athletics Carnival at Jamison Enclosed Oval which is just behind Big Splash and can be accessed from the Big Splash car park, on Thursday 19th October. Students will need to make their own way and meet directly at the Jamison Enclosed Oval before 8:40am. ACE rolls will be marked at the oval. Students will be at Jamison Enclosed Oval for the day and will be dismissed in time to catch buses home. **The cost for each student on the day will be \$5 to cover the venue and other costs (if this is a problem please contact the front office ASAP).** Money is to be paid at the gate upon entry.

Please Note: Students intending to participate in the 1500m NEED to be at the venue before 8:15am to warm up for their event.

All students are expected to attend the carnival as it is a compulsory part of the Canberra High School curriculum. School spirit, sportsmanship, socialisation and participation are strongly encouraged. The carnival will include traditional and novelty events for all students, or they may assist one of the staff members or House Captains with their jobs on the day.

Canteen facilities will be available with a sausage sizzle - \$2 and drinks - \$1 from 10am.

House colours should be worn: (ie. appropriate coloured shirt), sunscreen should be applied regularly and it is the **responsibility of the students** to monitor this. It is suggested that students wear a hat and sunglasses with a long sleeved shirt as it may be hot. Students should also bring a water bottle, there will be big water containers available for student use.

WET WEATHER ARRANGEMENTS: In case of severe weather conditions announcements will be made over radio stations 104.7 and 106.3 from 7.30am onwards and information will be posted on the school website. **If the event is cancelled, a normal school day will proceed.**

Parents who would like to attend the carnival in an official or spectator role are most welcome. However it will be necessary that you make contact with us detailing your intentions prior to the carnival so that appropriate arrangements can be made. If you can offer your assistance as a timekeeper or judge please call the SHAPE faculty.
