1	Intro to Satire	All work and resources will be presented on a Google Site. Covers <ul style="list-style-type: none">- What is satire? Definition- Why is satire used?- Why is it important?- What techniques are used in satire?-
2	Satire in TV	Focus example: The Simpsons Delivery: Slideshow discussing the following <ul style="list-style-type: none">- Why TV is used as a medium to deliver satire.- What <i>The Simpsons</i> is- An exploration of the popular satirical devices used by The Simpsons, including examples.- A Google Form to test student analytical knowledge with accompanying clips..- A viewing task showing a Simpsons episode with an attached template document to answer questions.
3	Satire in Film	Primary example: Mean Girls Delivery: Slideshow discussing the following <ul style="list-style-type: none">- Why film is used as a medium to deliver satire.

		<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - What Mean Girls is. - An exploration of the popular satirical devices used by Mean Girls, including examples. - A Google Form to test student analytical knowledge with accompanying clips. - A creative task where students exaggerate their own school social group to fit the satire of Mean Girls.
4	Satire in Political Cartoons/ Art	<p>Primary example: Several political cartoons and art pieces from various cartoonists and artists.</p> <p>Delivery: Slideshow discussing the following</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Why art is used as a medium to deliver satire. - What <i>Political Cartoons are</i>. - An exploration of the popular satirical devices used by political cartoons and art, including examples. - A Google Form to test student analytical knowledge with accompanying images. - Students will participate in a caricature task to explore the medium of art. - Discuss how caricatures rob people of their untouchable power to make them vulnerable and so that they can be mocked.
5	Work on assessment	Students can take this time to work on either their creative or analytical assignment.
6	Satire in News	<p>Primary example: The Chaser and The Onion.</p> <p>Delivery: Slideshow discussing the following</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Why news is used as a medium to deliver satire. - What <i>satirical news is</i>. - An exploration of the popular satirical devices used by political cartoons and art, including examples. - A Google Form to test student analytical knowledge with accompanying images/video. - Students will build upon their creative skills by writing their own short satirical news story along with a great newspaper generator app.
7	Satire in Music	Primary examples: Stupid Girls
8	Work on assessment: Students will complete assignments / other tasks as necessary, with teacher support and feedback.	

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10	Satire in Film	Viewing satire examples (film) OR Analysis of other examples, using resources contained in the Year 10 learning hub.
