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<p><u>Equipment Required:</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Mountain Bike in good working order (Can use CHS bikes for a fee) • Helmet - Australian Standards Approved with sticker evident. (Can use CHS helmets) • <u>Water-</u> Students without water will not be able to participate. • Gloves (recommended) • Eye wear (recommended) 	<p><u>Other information</u></p> <p>Students will be riding mountain bike trails (fire trails and single tracks) at Bruce Ridge regularly. We intend to ride out to the Arboretum trails also this year as one of our regular rides. Other afternoons, students will be able to travel to Stromlo Forrest Park and Majura Pines. Students will have to complete at least 3 rides at Bruce Ridge <u>and</u> demonstrate an adequate level of skills at Bruce Ridge before being allowed to participate in rides that require a higher level of skill at Stromlo or Majura Pines.</p> <p><u>NB: Mountain biking can be a dangerous activity; students are encouraged to ride within their limits.</u></p>								
<p><u>Ambulance Cover:</u> Students are strongly advised to have ambulance cover. If students hit their head and are suspected of having concussion, an ambulance will be called.</p>									

Excursions are offered to enrich student learning. Students are expected to catch up on any work missed whilst on excursion and are encouraged to talk to their teachers beforehand.

Students are expected to be in full school uniform when attending excursions.

- *The school has made every effort to keep cost for this activity at a responsible level. We have an equity fund which can be used to provide financial assistance for students where parents are unable to make the requested contribution.*
- *Staff accompanying students on excursions will take all reasonable care while the students are in their charge to protect them from injury and to control and supervise their behaviour and activities.*
- *Parents should be aware that staff members are not responsible for injuries or damage to property which may occur on an excursion where, in all circumstances, staff have not been negligent. Parents should warn children of the risk to themselves, to others and to property, of impulsive, wilful or disobedient behaviour.*

Due to COVID-19 we will offer rides in accordance with current restrictions. This may mean reduced rides or capped numbers-these may change across the course of the semester.

I give permission for my child _____ to participate in the JLP Mountain Biking Club and to **travel by private vehicle** with a teacher for the purpose of mountain biking at Stromlo Forrest Park or Majura Pines.
