## Subject: 9 Wood

During Term 3, students will learn, discover and develop skills in woodwork and design. This term will have an underlying theme of learning how to cut and join timber forms. Emphasis will be placed on skill development, safe and appropriate use of tools and equipment and attention to detail.

Week	Topic	Content/Activity/Tasks
1- July 20	Introduction and safety	Introduction to the course Begin safety booklet
2- July 27	Practice joints	Demonstrate and practical lessons on rebate joint and finger joint
3- August 3	Practice joints	Complete practice joints for submission and begin marking out cheese platter
4- August 10	Cheese platter prac	Continue marking out and cutting legs for cheese platter
5- August 17	Cheese platter prac	Cutting joining pieces for platter top, paying attention to measurements (numeracy)
6- August 24		Continue marking, cutting and joining components of cheese platter paying attention to measurements (numeracy)
7- August 31	Assembling components of Cheese platter	Assembling components of Cheese platter legs and top - glue and clamp
8- September 7		Learn about materials and specific equipment. Set study task for next week's test
9- September 14	General knowledge	Test students general knowledge on timber terms, tools and equipment used thus far
10- September 21	Final design features and completion Cheese platter	Add design features to Cheese platter - wood burn, laser cutter



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
