CyberTaipan Challenge 2018

Dear Parent/Caregiver,

Our school has been invited to participate in the CyberTaipan 2018. In the Challenge. More information about the challenge is available at: <https://www.austcyber.com/cybertain/>

Competitors will be in groups of 5-6 and 5 students will be involved in the competition rounds with the sixth member able to be an observer.

The dates to be aware of are:

7 September – 5 October: Training round begins. This will be run at the school during lunch times over those weeks so students become familiar with the system.

11 October – 23 October: Final practice round begins. Same as above.

Sunday 4 November: Round 1. All teams compete with the final results sent to Team Coaches and released on the Leaderboard.

Sunday 9 December: Round 2. All teams compete with final results sent to Team Coaches and released on the Leaderboard. Teams progressing to the National Finals are notified soon after.

March 2019: National Finals! Top 10 teams get an all-expenses paid trip to Canberra, ACT to compete in the national finals.

What do you have to do?

You will need to complete the attached enrolment form and hand it to the front office by **Friday 31 August 2018**. Students will need to be available to compete in the competition rounds. They run for **six hours** and will be held on a Sunday. We will run it at the school from **8:30am – 3:00pm on Sunday 4th November and Sunday 9th December**.

There is no cost involved. Students **do not** need to be in school uniform on Competition days but do need to bring what is needed on a normal school day (e.g. food, water, etc.). There will be no opportunity to purchase anything on the days.
