

Information Note- Junior Debating Competition Semester 1 2018

The Junior Open Competition will be held on Monday afternoons at Canberra Girls Grammar School in B Block (map attached). There will be 2 prepared rounds (where students get 5 days of preparation time) and 4 impromptu rounds (where students get 1 hour of preparation time), making 6 rounds in total. There are 3 debate time slots, these are 5.30pm, 6:30pm and 7.30pm. In the impromptu rounds students should arrive an hour early (so 4.30pm, 5.30pm, and 6:30pm respectively) to prepare for their debate.

Students need to make their own way to the venue. We recommend car pooling if possible with other students.

Round 5 - Monday 30th April

Grand Final - Tuesday 29th May
