ATHLETICS CARNIVAL **Friday 5th April 2019**

Dear Parent / Guardian,

We will be holding our annual Athletics Carnival at Aranda Oval (across Bindubi street from Canberra high school) on Friday 5th April. Students will need to arrive at school as though it is a normal school day (before 8:40am) so their name can get marked off in ACE and they will then be escorted across Bindubi street to the venue by their ACE teacher.

ACE locations for the day:

- Denman & Gowrie will meet in the **HALL**
- Fisher & Lyons will meet in the **GYM**

Students will be at Aranda Oval for the whole day and will be dismissed in time to catch buses home at the end of the day. **The cost for each student on the day will be \$5 to cover the venue hire and other costs (if this is a problem please contact the front office ASAP).** Money is to be paid to your ACE teacher on the day.

All students are expected to attend the carnival as it is a compulsory part of the Canberra High School curriculum. School spirit, sportsmanship, socialisation and participation are strongly encouraged. The carnival will include traditional and novelty events for all students, or they may assist one of the staff members or House Captains with their jobs on the day.

Canteen facilities will be available with a sausage sizzle - \$2 and drinks - \$1 from 10am.

House colours should be worn: (ie. appropriate coloured shirt, DENMEN – Red, FISHER – Blue, GOWRIE – Green, LYONS - Yellow), sunscreen will be available and should be applied regularly and it is the **responsibility of the students** to monitor this. It is suggested that students wear a hat and sunglasses with a long sleeved shirt as it may be hot. Students should also bring a water bottle so they can best utilise the big water containers that are made available for student use.

WET WEATHER ARRANGEMENTS: In case of severe weather conditions announcements will be made on the school website and each year groups Google Classroom pages. **If the event is cancelled, a normal school day will proceed, although the canteen will not be available.**

Parents who would like to attend the carnival in an official or spectator role are most welcome. However it will be necessary that you make contact with us detailing your intentions prior to the carnival so that appropriate arrangements can be made (WWVP etc.).
