



Dear Parent/Guardian

To obtain a Learner’s Licence in the ACT students must first successfully complete the Road Ready course.

Canberra High School will be providing Year 10 Students with an opportunity to complete a Road Ready course after school in terms one and two or in terms three and four in 2017. The Road Ready program is a road safety course that focuses on minimising dangerous and risk-taking behaviours.

The term one and two course will be offered after school and students will need to attend either a Tuesday or a Wednesday afternoon sessions from 3.00pm to 4.00pm starting week 8. Classes will run for 13 weeks with 13 sessions in total. Following the successful completion of the theory component of the course (Tues or Wed Week 9 of Term 2), students will undertake an on line multiple choice test (Tues or Wed Week 10 Term 2). Upon passing the test students will be issued with a certificate enabling them to obtain an ACT Learner’s Permit.

Students will be required to attend every Road Ready session (13 in total) commencing in the eighth week of term one or for the second course in the first week of term three. The cost of the course is \$35 per student payable by the end of term one.

The bottom section of the sheet must be completed signed and returned to the front office by the end of week 7 (14 March). The course fee must be paid to the front office before the end of term 1.

Please Note: The Road Ready Course is not a compulsory part of the school curriculum and students can undertake the road ready course with other providers outside the school at another time if they wish.
