

Dear Parent/Guardian,

To obtain a Learner's Licence in the ACT students must first successfully complete the Road Ready Course.

Canberra High School will be providing Year 10 Students with an opportunity to complete a Road Ready Course after school in terms two and three in 2021. The Road Ready program is a road safety course that focuses on minimising dangerous and risk-taking behaviours.

The Road Ready Course will be offered after school and students will need to attend on either a Tuesday or Wednesday afternoon session from 3.00pm to 4.30pm commencing in Week 1, Term 2 (for Semester 1). The Semester 2 classes will commence in Week 1 of Term 3. There will be up to 80 places offered each semester. Classes will run for 9 weeks (13 hours in total). Following the successful completion of the theory component of the course (first 8 weeks), students will undertake an on-line multiple-choice test at lunchtime in Week 9. Upon passing the test and completing all class requirements, students will be issued with a certificate enabling them to obtain an ACT Learner's Permit.

Students will be required to attend every Road Ready session (8 in total) and catch up if they miss a lesson.
